Themed Shows

Casey has arranged and performed many themed shows, designed to transport the audience to a particular place and time in music history. Some of these programs include:

- Dreams and Wishes: Treasures from the Walt Disney Songbook, featuring songs from the Walt Disney Company spanning more than 75 years
- Heart Songs and Musical Valentines, featuring popular love songs from throughout the 20th century
- Lullabies of Broadway: Songs from the Golden Age, featuring songs from classic musicals of the 20th century

- Old American Favorites, featuring songs in a variety of styles by American composers from the first half of the 20th century
- Be My Love, featuring some of the greatest love songs of all time, popularized in the late nineteenth and first half of the twentieth centuries
- *I've Got a Pocket Full of Dreams*, a second tribute to Bing Crosby
- All Around the World, featuring songs inspired by a variety of locations throughout the world

- A Grand Night For Singing: A Tribute to Rodgers and Hammerstein
- We'll Gather Lilacs Sentimental Songs of Springtime
- A Little Night Music: Casey Jones Costello Sings Broadway and Beyond, featuring works by some of the greatest songwriters of the 20th century such as Alan Menken, Stephen Sondheim, Jerome Kern and Andrew Lloyd Webber
